Team Build Day Info

Group Size: We welcome groups of all sizes and are generally able to manage large groups with advance notice.

Location and Schedule: For up to date location information contact our Volunteer Coordinator at 810.766.9089 ext. 203 or volunteer@geneseehabitat.org. The work day typically begins at 9:30 am and ends at 3:30 pm. Please arrive promptly at 9:30 am for safety training.

Dates: Any Wednesday through Saturday. Please provide us a date range and a preferred day of the week, and we will let you know what dates are open that match your availability.

Lunch: Lunch is a great time to take a break and learn more about Habitat. It is expected that your team will arrange to provide lunch on the job site for your group.

Waiver: Volunteers must sign a waiver. The minimum volunteer age is 18 years old. Volunteers under 18 can be accommodated with advance notice.

What to Wear/Bring: Habitat builds in all weather conditions, so dress for the weather and wear layers. Wear sturdy, comfortable clothing that you do not mind getting dirty or stained. No open-toe shoes. All tools and safety hats are provided.

Since its founding Genesee County Habitat for Humanity has built or renovated over 152 homes throughout Genesee County. It is made up of people who volunteer their time and work to provide decent, affordable homes for persons who could not otherwise afford to buy a home. Habitat is financed through donations of money and materials and houses are sold at no profit, and no interest, typically over a 20-year period.
